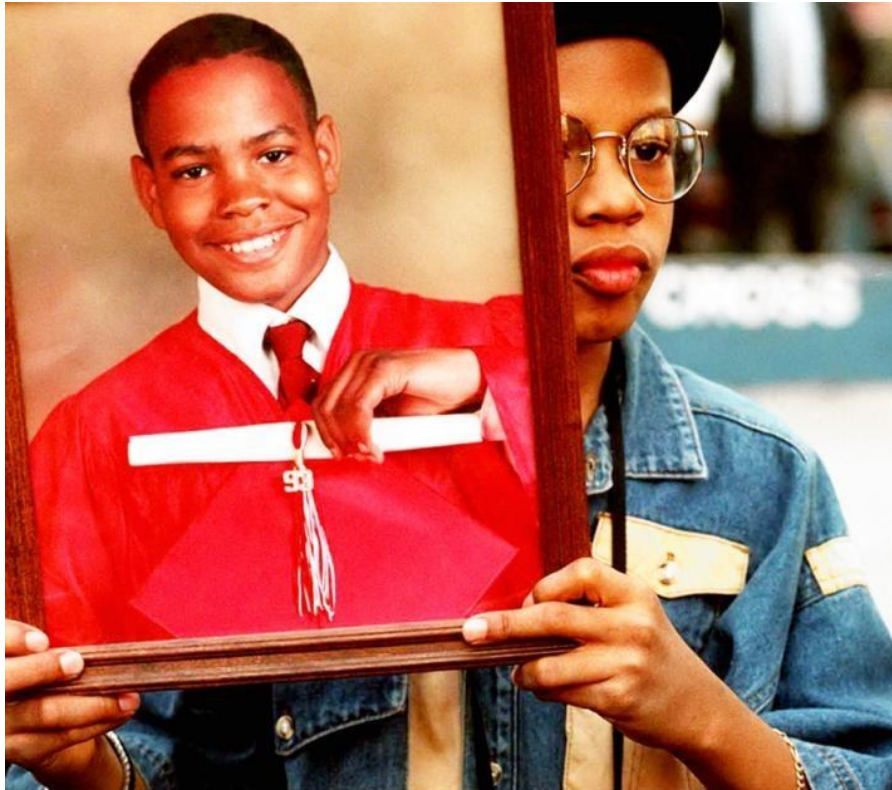


# 21st Annual Day of Remembrance for Nicholas Naquan Heyward, Jr.
